America's young people are its most precious resource. For many years, Exchange Clubs and National Headquarters have sponsored an impressive selection of activities designed to benefit and encourage our nation's youth. The A.C.E. AWARD program is one of those activities!

The program recognizes high school students who have made a dramatic change in their attitude and/or performance during their high school years. These changes have enabled the students to overcome adversities and prepare for graduation.

A.C.E. is a positive program with two key objectives:

- It helps encourage students to overcome their hardships and get back on track toward a high school diploma.
- It recognizes students who are often overlooked for their accomplishments. This special recognition serves as a powerful example to all students that hard work and perseverance really do pay.

Planning is the key to successful implementation of the program in your community! •

Start by forming a project committee that will study the information about the A.C.E. program on the www.nationalexchangeclub.org website and adapt the program to your community.

- Define the award criteria.
- Determine what the award will be – recognition, plaque, certificate, money, learning resource, ...
- Promote the program to your club and your community.

There are numerous organizations in your community that work with candidates for this award; examples include:

- High Schools – school guidance counselors, social workers, and teachers (coaches, music, art, ...)
- Churches
- Community recreation centers
- Law enforcement agencies
- Rehabilitation centers

The committee must lead and manage the program throughout the duration of the project, which usually coincides with the school year. Enter your A.C.E. winner in the Georgia District Exchange Club A.C.E. competition! The prize is a check for \$1,500. The District winner will be entered in the National Exchange Club A.C.E. competition! That prize is a \$15,000 scholarship to an accredited post-secondary school!
